NOTICE OF PUBLIC SALE

The Correctional Industries Division of the Alabama Department of Corrections is now receiving sealed bids for the disposal of approximately 15,000 pounds of motor vehicle license plate die scrap and plate rejects (Lot 1), and approximately 2,500 pounds scrap steel (Lot 2). The license plate scrap consists of rolled aluminum substrate to which reflective vinyl sheeting is adhered. The aluminum is alloy 3105, temper H-28, and is .022" thick. Both lots are located at the Holman Correctional Facility Industry Operations, 866 Ross Road, Atmore, AL 36503. Successful Bidder(s) have twenty-days to remove material once notification is provided that the bid has been accepted. Payment must be in the form of a cashiers check made payable to Alabama Correctional Industries. Payment must be accompanied by 1) a weigh ticket from scales certified for commerce, and 2) a sworn and notarized statement that material payment weight is accurate. Successful bidder shall be responsible for removal of material from plant.
